
In this modern free-for-all twist on the classic game of dodgeball, we're going to be throwing (and dodging) balls in the Activity Center. We have a few other games lined up involving

## **Confirmation Retreat**

Sept. 17th - 19th Friday—Sunday

We are joining many other churches from all over Texas for a 3-day, 2-night trip to Camp Lonestar in La Grange, TX. We will also be having a very special Confirmation class one of the days at camp! Please register your child ahead of time. Contact Austin Angerman if you are interested in attending as a parent volunteer or if you are interested in driving.

### Note to Parents:

Confirmation class will be from 1:00pm until 2:30pm, every-other Sunday. *There might be an exception to this in November due to Thanksgiving.* 

Our class schedule will be:

Lesson teaching	1:00pm-2:00pm
A 15-minute break	2:00pm-2:15pm
Discussion with parents	2:15pm—2:30pm

Please arrive at 2:15pm to sit with your child and participate in our closing discussion time! We will always end promptly at 2:30pm, and we always wrap up with 15 minutes for Confirmation students to talk with their parent about what they learned in class that day. If your child is absent for whatever reason, each Confirmation class will be filmed and they will be able to watch a recording of the lesson to get caught up with the rest of class. If possible, please notify us about absences ahead of time!

### Materials and Cost

We use the "Enduring Faith" Confirmation curriculum released by Concordia Publishing House, as well as Luther's Small Catechism and a Faith Alive ESV Bible.

To offset some of the cost, we are asking 7th grade families to



contribute \$20 for each student they are enrolling into Confirmation. Either cash or check is fine!
